Særlige fokuspunkter	<p>The aim of this topic is to introduce the students to their first area study/landeportræt. We start off with research work - basic and general facts about the UK - and students are given the opportunity to share their findings with the rest of the class.</p> <p>The main focus of the second part of the topic is on British society + attitudes to class difference and inequality.</p> <p>Material selected covers various genres with the intention of (a) introducing various analytical methods relevant to the genre (b) giving students a deeper insight into British culture and society.</p>

Særlige fokuspunkter	<p>This course focuses on giving students the opportunity to read a novel in English and to work with each chapter in depth individually and in groups. The novel chosen fits in well as a continuation of work on British society – focus is now on homelessness and inequality.</p> <p>Students are introduced to new analytical terms and now learn how to apply the PEE-system also in respect to their oral work. Students are expected to present in-depth characterizations of the protagonists, setting as well as to recognize and apply terms such as dual narration, dramatic irony etc. Also, students are trained to recognize the difference between a reliable/unreliable narrator.</p> <p>The course ends with an analysis of <i>Stone Cold</i> in groups followed by oral presentation of their findings.</p>

Særlige fokuspunkter	<p>After working with fiction, students are now be given the opportunity to work with non-fiction and with a business-related topic.</p> <p>They are first introduced to various texts to enable them to gain a vocabulary on the subject. Next, students are introduced to characteristics of an entrepreneur/hero + traditional American values followed by historic facts/fiction on some of the most important American entrepreneurs of the past. This includes working with an analysis of docu-series.</p> <p>The rest of the course introduces students to other well-known entrepreneurs – American and British – and continuation of work with analytical methods such as speech analysis, in-depth characterization, documentary analysis etc.</p> <p>Written assignment – students are introduced to the communicate assignment 4A (speech manuscript).
